<p><b>EGISDBP2 SQL Server Update</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Upgraded to SQL Server 2017</li><li>Any issues?</li><li>Restart tonight at 9:05pm (5-10 minutes downtime)</li></ul> <p>Automated CAMS extracts failing since the upgrade – working to resolve the issues and manually extracting in the meantime. Need to recreate the locator with the new Create Locator tool. Otherwise, the upgrade went smoothly and no other outstanding issues.</p>	Rob

<p><b>Updated City Boundaries</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Process for adding to repository</li> <li>• Coordinating eGIS and DPW approach</li> </ul> <p>From Jimmy Chen:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Create eGIS_Boundaries_Political.EGIS.DPW_CITY_BOUNDARIES_NEW_SCHEMA.</li> <li>2. Each map service owner republishes with eGIS_Boundaries_Political.EGIS.DPW_CITY_BOUNDARIES_NEW_SCHEMA ahead of time, changing any needed configs like pop-ups</li> <li>3. Schema change occurs on original eGIS_Boundaries_Political.EGIS.DPW_CITY_BOUNDARIES</li> <li>4. Republish services to eGIS_Boundaries_Political.EGIS.DPW_CITY_BOUNDARIES</li> </ol> <p>Focus on minimizing down time. eGIS will give plenty of lead time to adjust/test new schema before changing the main table.</p>	<p>PW / eGIS</p>

Removing “1” from end of some layer names, taking out fields that are not meaningful externally.
