
eGIS Team Updates

August 2022

LARIAC (An)

- The 3rd and Final Frequent Image Capture flight for LARIAC6 began mid July 2022.
- All initial flight plans have been completed. Planes are on site to recapture images that didn't meet specs
- EagleView plans on finish flying by the end of this week.



Final delivery should be around mid or end of September

LARIAC (An)

- Image capture for LARIAC 7 is expected to begin in early 2023. We are processing an amendment to extend the EXST contract with EagleView to collect data for LARIAC7
- 41 organizations have confirmed their intent to participate in LARIAC 7 (either via a Letter of Intent or a signed Participant Agreement) representing approximately \$4.3M in funding resources.
- The GIO is still in discussions with several other potential entities about becoming members of the consortium.
- SOW for Street-Level LiDAR/Imagery is under initial review before going to the TAG for review & comments. Once TAG approves the SOW, we will start the procurement process with an RFP
- Staff are now drafting the SOW for the Frequent Image Capture program for LARIAC.
