From Seth at Esri: "If you guys have public facing feature services, I can start looking at them and come up with an initial data engineering plan, and even set some of these up for you guys. I'd like to make this as painless as possible. If you guys keep up your layers in your Hub site, we'll take it from there."

<p>Idea: create a REST endpoint with all the layers we'd like to share – give that to Esri and they can run with it. eGIS to handle the process.</p> <p>This is the list of accepted layers from Esri - https://communitymaps.arcgis.com/home/layers</p>	
<p>Sensitive Uses Mapping / LMS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tracking sensitive use features in LMS (schools, parks, libraries, places of worship, etc.) Current LMS Management System URL: https://lms.gis.lacounty.gov/ LMS Planning Teams site Discussion/strategy <p>Pick back up work to clean and plan for maintenance of LMS. Data sources available elsewhere do not need to be stored locally in the system, or at least we need an ETL strategy. Working session scheduled to begin to finalize recommendations to bring back to the next committee meeting.</p> <p>LMS and Land Types are different representations of the same system.</p> <p>Junior/eGIS looked into availability of 211 – we no longer have an established method of receiving that data, so we'll need to start over and make the necessary connections if we would like to have it again.</p> <p>Some projects where we have used/needed a 'sensitive uses' layer:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Billboards (early 2000's) Jessica's Law / sex offenders (2010/2012) Cannabis (2017) Alcohol Sales (2021) Gun Dealers (2022) <p>RE: Sensitive Uses - this is sample language from one of our ordinances: "The standards and requirements in this Chapter shall apply to any new sensitive use, including dwelling units (except for accessory dwelling units), schools and school yards, parks, playgrounds, daycare centers, preschools, nursing homes, hospitals, and daycares or preschools as accessory to a place of worship...."</p>	<p>Dan (20)</p>
