<p>Census Boundaries Updates and Schema Changes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Census Tract 2020 and Block Group 2020 data update along shoreline/coastal area as per DPW City boundary data update. • Questions/Discussion regarding Census Blocks 2020 data and schema following Santa Clarita City “Tesoro Del Valle” annexation <p>This item took majority of the meeting time – good discussion of process options for incremental changes in Census data.</p> <p>Census Blocks 2020 is a “snapshot” and we will leave as-is with FIP20 and BGFIP20 fields.</p> <p>Split tracts can be used for joining Census boundaries to CSAs – these will update as annexations or other city/unincorporated boundary changes happen. Latest split tracts are in the members drive, we need to also add them in the repository.</p> <p>General review needed for Demographic data in the repository: move relevant data only on members drive into the repository, review what’s currently there and deprecate/archive as appropriate. We need a process for deprecation and periodic review to identify candidate layers.</p>	<p>Durga (10)</p>

There are up to 20+ categories for some locations, which are all listed pipe-delimited for each in the allcats field.</p> <p>Mark and Rob are actively working on the points of interest dataset, should have it for review at next meeting.
